2024 PARADE OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Our Mission: University United Festival and Parade is a family-oriented event that seeks to promote pride and unity in the community. It is to celebrate and inspire residents, families, individuals, and the community to participate in positive activities. The parade is to showcase the tremendous pride of all who participate and a diverse community as the University District embraces. These rules and regulations are to promote a safe event.

Obey Parade Route: All participates must read and adhere to the Buffalo Police Department "Permit for Parade". All participants will be given a copy to review at parade participate meeting.

Vehicles Must Be Registered: All motorized vehicles and attached trailers must be legally registered and licensed

Insurance Policy: Sponsors and promoters of the University United Festival and Parade and their agents and employees shall not be liable for loss of personal property, personal injury or other damages involving a parade participant or participant's agents and employees.

Politics and Politeness: Banners, signs, songs, etc. that advocate causes and issues are welcomed. However, those that endorse specific candidates or political parties that denigrate other person or viewpoints, or that in the opinion of Parade organizers are intended to gather attention through negative reaction are not permitted.

Staging: All vehicles must be in place and parked by 1:00PM, an hour before the Parade will start in the lineup

Nothing Can Be Tossed or Thrown from the Street into the Crowd: If you want to distribute candy, stickers, small trinkets, etc., which we discourage but do not forbid, this must be done only by adults walking beside the curb.

Animals: Groups with horses must include appropriate clean-up crews. All dogs must be leashed.

Driver's Instructions: Once the parade starts, staff/volunteers along the route work to keep it moving smoothly and without delay. Please be mindful about your start times and follow instructions as given by the Parade staff/volunteers without argument.

WHAT TIME IS THE PARADE AND WHAT TIME DO WE NEED TO CHECK IN?

The parade will take place Saturday, June 10 from 2PM-3PM. The parade will start at Bailey & E. Amherst St. and travel down Bailey heading towards UB South Campus and end at Bailey & Sherman (across from the VA Hospital).

Parade participant check-in will be from 12:30PM-1:00PM at Westminster Community School.
